INT. CAMP SAFE HAVEN, KITCHEN - AFTERNOON

Harvey and Janice work in the kitchen along with a few other campers. They work alongside each other prepping food for fifty.

HARVEY

She tells me I'm too optimistic, and when I smile, I look like I'm thinking about murdering her.

JANICE

Are you thinking about murdering her?

HARVEY

Sometimes!

JANICE

Harvey.

HARVEY

She wouldn't have anything to complain about, that's all I'm saying.

Janice doesn't dignify him with a response. They move dishes around the kitchen in a tense silence. Harvey breaks first.

HARVEY (CONT'D)

She's just so angry all the time, you know? It's just like constantly boiling under the surface, and it comes out in these harsh snaps and it's like... it's like she doesn't believe things will ever get better, so she's not even willing to try.

JANICE Sounds familiar.

HARVEY

It does?

JANICE You know, about a year ago, Masters comes up to me and she says we got a new camper.

HARVEY Oh, come on Janice.

JANICE

Says she wants me to be his sponsor. Never asked me to do that before, on account of my short temper and bristly demeanor.

HARVEY

You're not bristly.

JANICE

You're lucky I'm bristly. You wouldn't have made it a week here if you didn't have someone willing to put up with your shit.

HARVEY

I love this place.

JANICE

And when you got here, you were ready to fight anyone who so much as offered you a glass of water.

HARVEY

I wasn't that bad.

JANICE

You were angry, Harvey. You were hurt and you spent most of your life isolated in a crowded room, and that made you angry and defensive.

HARVEY

Well, maybe, but -

JANICE

There's no but, Shaw. You were in a bad place, and you were afraid to let anyone close enough to help you.

HARVEY That was different.

JANICE How do you figure?

HARVEY

My powers hurt people, Janice, you know that. You... you know that better than anyone here except Ms. Masters.

She blows shit up when she gets nervous.

HARVEY

She does?

Janice stops working and turns to level Harvey with a look of disbelief.

JANICE You haven't asked her about her powers?

HARVEY

I did! She said it was a rude question and ditched me at lunch.

JANICE

It is a rude question. She took out half a city block. People chased her all over the country.

HARVEY Because of her powers?

JANICE Because her powers hurt people.

HARVEY

I didn't know that.

JANICE

But you did assume. Everyone like us is angry in some way, Harvey. It's not a fair thing, having this kind of power thrust on you. But maybe Ms. Masters saw that you're both angry in the same way, and thought you could help each other.

HARVEY

I don't think -

JANICE

Man up, Shaw. Help Anika find her place here. But pass me the salt, first. You can't season to save your life.
